



## Tocal Homestead Covid Safety Plan

## Visitor Reception & Sunday Openings – Public

# As regulations change, the following regulations will be reviewed. These are the protocols we currently have in place.

### We have strict policies in place but need your help with these steps:

- Please be patient with our staff. Things may take a little longer than usual as we practise a high level of safe hygiene changing of gloves between your meals, washing hands, sanitising surfaces, etc.
- Your details we must capture your details via the Service NSW app. If your phone is not compatible, we will provide you with a sheet to write down your details. This is kept for 28 days and then destroyed.
- Eftpos is preferred over cash.
- Maintain physical distancing 1.5 metres.
- One person per 2 square metres (including staff):
  - 25 patrons are allowed at any one time in Visitor Centre's before the 2m2 rule applies, if safe to do so under physical distancing parameters.
  - Rooms inside the Homestead; please take note to the signs on the floor as you enter each room displaying a number. That is the maximum amount of people allowed in that room.
  - Outbuildings; please adhere to the one person per 2m2 rule.
- Our staff will be wearing appropriate PPE when serving your refreshments at the Visitor Centre.
- Please reschedule your visit if you have any symptoms a cold, fever, cough, loss of taste or smell.

#### If you feel unwell whilst on site:

- Immediately go to the Visitor Centre and inform a staff member.
- Go home, isolate, and contact your nearest Covid-19 testing centre to get tested.
- Follow the rules that are then given to you by the appropriate authorities.
