As our community becomes more active and gets back to business, it's important that we:

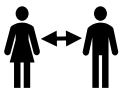
- Follow the rules about gatherings, self-isolation and quarantine.

- Encourage staff to access Covid-19 vaccination
- Get tested if symptoms exist, even if they are only mild.
- Follow NSW Health advice about staying home while waiting for test results.

Safety Feature

- Staff follow all safety protocols as directed by local authorities
- Hand sanitiser in guest accommodation



Physical Distancing

- Contactless payment options
- Physical distancing and mask rules followed by staff and in place for guests



Cleaning

- Use of cleaning chemicals that are effective against Covid19
- Linens, towels and laundry washed in accordance with local authority guidelines
- Guest accommodation disinfected between stays
- Guests can opt-out of room cleaning service
- Replacement and/or removal of non-essential items



Food & Drink Safety

- Contactless delivery of breakfast hampers to guest accommodation
- Plates, cutlery, glasses and other tableware frequently sanitised

If you feel unwell whilst on site:

- Immediately notify a staff member
- Go home, isolate, and contact your nearest Covid-19 testing centre to get tested
- Follow the rules that are then given to you by the appropriate authorities
